Immigration Regulations

All F-1 & J-1 students must be enrolled for a full course load every semester. A full course load is defined as 12 credit hours for undergraduate students and 9 credit hours for graduate students.

There are very limited situations in which you are allowed to drop below a full course load.

During the first or second semester only:

- Initial Difficulty with English Language
- Initial Difficulty with Reading Requirements
- Initial Difficulty with American Teaching Methods
- Initial Improper Course Level Placement

During the **final semester only**:

To Complete Course of Study in the Final Semester

Cautions

- Except in the final semester, you cannot reduce your course load below six credit hours.
- > To drop below full-time status, you must first have the permission of your academic advisor and the International Student Advisor.
- ➤ Dropping below full-time status before you receive permission from your academic advisor and the International Student Advisor means you have violated your legal student status and will have to apply for reinstatement. You may only drop below 12 credit hours after you have received explicit permission from the international student advisor.
- You are allowed only one approved reduced course load excluding the final semester of each degree level.
- In the final semester of your program, you are allowed to take less than a full course load if that is the number of credits needed to complete your degree.

Procedures

- 1. Discuss your progress in the class with your professor.
- 2. Discuss the situation with your academic advisor.
- 3. Complete the Application for a Reduced Course Load with your Academic Advisor.
- 4. Make an appointment with the International Student Advisor or Director of the Center for International Students at Baldwin Hall 104 or iso01@truman.edu.
- 5. If the International Student Advisor approves your request, they will add the permission to your SEVIS Record and notify you to drop the course through TruView.
